April Arc Flash Training Includes 2012 NFPA 70E Update

Two training sessions on NFPA 70E Qualified-Level Arc Flash Safety will be offered to MSCA members on April 12, 2012 — one at 8:00 a.m., Eastern Time and the second at 11:00 a.m., Eastern Time. This Web-based course is approximately 90 minutes long and being offered at a special rate exclusively for MSCA members.
