





UA VIP Program Puts Vets to Work in the HVACR Industry

The UA and MSCA would like to thank MSCA members McKinstry Services (Seattle, WA), MacDonald Miller (Seattle, WA) and MESA Energy Systems/EMCOR (Irvine, CA) for hiring students from the first graduating class of the UA Veterans In Piping (VIP) HVACR program. Each of these contractors will be hiring two of the graduating students who will

immediately bring valuable skills and a solid work ethic to the company.



The UA's VIP HVACR program is eighteen weeks (720 hours) of intensive HVACR training. During this training these military veterans will complete the following UA certifications: UA 51 Brazing certification, 410 A certification, OSHA 30 hour certification, CFC certification, and CPR certification. At the conclusion of the class the student will take the UA Star Light Commercial HVACR exam. The program also focuses on the value and importance of customer relations. The program not only consists of classroom instruction but

also shop classes where students get involved with many hands-on projects. The UA VIP Program has had great success in providing training and careers in welding and expects similar successes in the ever-growing field of HVACR service. The UA anticipates offering this program in a number of different locations around the country in the future.

Life-Saving Arc Flash Program on July 12

Two training sessions on NFPA 70E Qualified-Level Arc Flash Safety will be offered to MSCA members on July 12, 2012 — one at 8:00 a.m., Eastern Time and the second at 11:00 a.m., Eastern Time.
