Ten graduates from the First, Joint Base Lewis-McChord Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration class were recognized for their completion of this intensive 18-week, 720-hour training program.

During this training, military veterans also complete the following UA certifications: UA 51 Brazing certification, 410 A certification, OSHA 30 hour certification, CFC certification, and CPR certification. The VIP program works in partnership with the U.S. military to provide veterans with the skills needed for a
